## **ACU approved Sand Racing Additional Supplementary Regulations 2010**

- 1 Promoters: Guernsey Motorcycle & Car Club LBG hereafter known as the Club.  
2 Competition for Motorcycles.  
3 Dates: April 17<sup>th</sup>, May 1<sup>st</sup>, May 15<sup>th</sup>, May 29<sup>th</sup>, June 12<sup>th</sup>, July 31<sup>st</sup>, Aug 14<sup>th</sup>, Aug 28<sup>th</sup>, Sept 25<sup>th</sup>, Oct 9<sup>th</sup>.  
4 Grade of Competition: CLUB RESTRICTED  
5 Each Meeting will be governed by the National Sporting Code Rules & Standing Supplementary  
6 Regulations of the ACU, these ASR's and any written instructions the Club may issue for the event.  
7 ACU Permit Numbers: TBA  
8 The event is open to all members of the Club provided that they are in possession of an ACU  
9 Licence valid for the event, which must be produced at the commencement of the Meeting.  
10 Competitors disqualified from holding a current road-driving license appropriate for the Class in which  
11 he/she wishes to enter, with the exception of the Juniors may be refused an entry. It will be at the discretion  
12 of the Club committee.  
13 Venue: Vazon Bay, Guernsey Length of track: 900 metres approx.  
14 Awards: To be announced in the programme.  
15 Entry fees: £35 senior, £22 junior. Late entries will be penalised £5 up to 24 hours before the Meeting and  
16 £10 thereafter. Entry fees are refundable except for £5 to cover administration costs, provided the  
17 Competition Secretary is informed 48 hours prior to the event  
18 Entries can be posted or handed in at the home of the Competition Secretary, Mrs M Rumens,  
19 Glenesk, Sandy Hook, St Sampson's, Guernsey. GY2 4ER Telephone 01481 246099  
20 Fax 01481 245593. Entries can also be taken to the Social Clubhouse **They must be placed in  
the Competition Box not Through the Front Door Letter Box.**  
21 The Clerk of the Course and Stewards of the Meeting: as per programme.  
22 Provisional results will be available at the end of the Meeting. Official results will be published in the Club  
23 News Report or on [www.gmccc.co.uk](http://www.gmccc.co.uk)  
24 Competitors must report to the Scrutineers one and a half hours before the start of the Meeting.  
25 Flag signals: as per ACU 2009 Handbook. Championship points: Points 6,4,3,2,1.  
26 Handicaps will be based on the performance in the scratch races in this and previous Meetings. Any  
27 Competitor who in any lap of a handicap race improves his/her best scratch lap time by more than 5% will  
28 be liable to a penalty or exclusion if a satisfactory explanation for such improvement is not forthcoming.  
29 The inner and outer limits of the track will be marked with cones/pylons/flags. Competitors must keep  
30 within the area bounded by the said markers and failure to do so for whatever reason may result in a penalty  
31 or exclusion from the race in progress.  
32 Entries must be submitted on the recognised entry form to the Competition Secretary of the Club which  
33 must be countersigned by a parent/guardian if the competitor is not of a legal age to sign the  
34 appropriate form.  
35 Classes: Juniors: As per ACU 2010 Handbook  
Seniors: Motorcycles up to 350cc & Motorcycles 351cc & over  
36 Competitors who permit their machine or any part of their person to cross or take out markers that define  
37 the course will be reported to the Clerk of the Course, who may exclude or penalise the competitor one lap,  
38 or may be excluded from the results, unless such action was taken in the interest of safety, or due to the  
39 actions of another rider  
40 Riders who are black flagged for riding recklessly may be banned from competing in the next race.  
41 All riders will be covered by Personal Accident and Competitors Third Party Insurance  
42 whilst practising and racing.  
43 Each Competitor must take adequate precautions to prevent oil and other fluids contaminating the Beach.  
44 The washing of motorcycles will be permitted provided that no detergents or pressure washers are used.  
45 No competitor is to leave the beach until the end of the Meeting without prior consent of the C of C.  
46 Juniors: Rules and safety regulations as per ACU 2010 handbook.
