## ACU approved Sand Racing Additional Supplementary Regulations 2022

- 1 Promoters: Guernsey Motorcycle & Car Club LBG hereafter known as the Club.
- 2 Competition for Motorcycles.
- 3 Dates: TBA
- 4 Grade of Competition: RESTRICTED
- 5 Each meeting will be governed by the National Sporting Code Rules & Standing Supplementary Regulations of the ACU, these ASR's and any written instructions the Club may issue for the event.
- 6 ACU Permit Numbers: T.B.A.
- 7 The event is open to all members of the promoting club and resident Jersey members of the JMC&LCC provided that they are in possession of an ACU License valid for the event.  
**Competition Licences and Club Membership Cards must be produced at signing on.**  
Competitors disqualified from holding a current road-driving license appropriate for the Class in which he/she wishes to enter, with the exception of the Juniors may be refused an entry, It will be at the discretion of the GMC & CC LBG committee.
- 8 Venue: Vazon Bay, Guernsey Length of track: 700 meters approx. Youth 550 meters max.
- 9 Entry fees: £32 senior solo, £40 sidecar, £29 junior. Late entries will be penalized £10 up to 24 hours before the Meeting and £10 thereafter. Entry fees are refundable except for £5 to cover administration costs, provided the Competition Secretary is informed 48 hours prior to the event.
- 10 Entries must be submitted on the recognized entry form and can be posted to or handed in at the home of the Competition Secretary, Mrs Sandra Le Page, Falstria, Beaulieu Crescent, Route Militaire, St Sampons GY24EA or online
- 11 The Clerk of the Course and Stewards of the Meeting: as per programme.
- 12 Official results will be posted on the Club website [www.gmccc.co.uk](http://www.gmccc.co.uk)
- 13 Competitors must report to the Technical Officials one and a half hours before the start of the Meeting.
- 14 Flag signals: As per ACU 2022 Handbook.(online)
- 15 Championship points for all classes: Points 15,12,10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1.
- 16 The method of starting will be by elastic tape.
- 17 Handicaps will be based on the performance in the scratch races in this and previous Meetings. Any Competitor who in any lap of a handicap race improves his/her best scratch lap time by more than 5% will be liable to a penalty or exclusion if a satisfactory explanation for such improvement is not forthcoming.
- 18 Youth Classes will be Cadets, Junior/Intermediate Track, Junior/Intermediate MX.  
Senior Classes will be Track Racing Motorcycles up to 500cc, MX Open A & B and R/H Sidecars up to 1000cc.
- 19 All riders will be covered by Personal Accident and Competitors Third Party Insurance whilst practicing and racing.
- 20 Each Competitor must take adequate precautions to prevent oil and other fluids contaminating the Beach.
- 21 The washing of motorcycles will be permitted provided that no detergents or pressure washers are used.
- 22 No competitor is to leave the beach until the end of the Meeting without prior consent of the C of C.
- 23 Youth classes: Safety regulations as per ACU 2022 handbook.(online)
- 24 Nobody will be trackside without appropriate Hi-Viz clothing at any time during the meeting.
